

Public Compliance Statement

- Peter McVerry Trust (PMVT) is committed to complying with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* as issued by the Charities Regulator in 2017.
- The basis for these Guidelines is in the 2008 Statement of Guiding Principles on Charitable Fundraising, which was developed by the Irish Charities Tax Reform Group (now Charities Institute Ireland)
- PMVT confirms its commitment to the Guidelines as set out in the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* by a statement to that effect in its annual report.
- PMVT has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public.
- PMVT regularly monitors compliance with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* and compliance reports are received regularly by the governing body.
- PMVT considers the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* when planning all fundraising activity.
- PMVT has a policy on working with third party fundraisers.
- PMVT has a complaints and feedback policy.
- PMVT provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.
- PMVT has appointed a member of the governing body and/or a senior member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public*.
- PMVT ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public*.
