#### **Delivering research**

Design, lead and manage all research projects and initiatives Monitor all research outputs and budgetary spending, ensuring projects are delivered to the agreed deadlines and budgets Establish strong research collaborations with third parties, including third-level institutions, NGOs, and government sectors

Ensure all research projects have a strong evidence base to inform and support PMVT service provision

Support the development of PMVT research publications to the highest standards

### Supporting and developing PMVT research capacity

Identify and obtain funding to facilitate the ongoing work of the department. Collaborating with the PMVT directors to ensure strategic initiatives are being met Support the research and information needs of other PMVT departments Attend conferences and dissemination events that will inform the organisation's current research findings and inform the organisation's future research

Demonstrate extensive knowledge of current and evolving legislation, national policy, and regulatory frameworks, as well as organisational policies, procedures, guidelines, and protocols.
